

Art Education Programs

Throughout the year, Arts on Main offers a variety of classes that have served over 700 participants of all ages, skill levels, and backgrounds! Your support means we can continue to provide new and changing ways for our community to engage with the arts.

First Fridays

Thanks to our First Friday Exhibit and Music sponsors, Arts on Main hosts free opening receptions for our monthly exhibit. More than 1,400 people joined us this past year to listen to live music, see a new exhibit, and connect with other art lovers.



RiverJam Music Festival

Our RiverJam Music Festival sponsors made it possible for nearly 400 people to join our Seventh Annual RiverJam Music Festival! We are thrilled to highlight the art of music through this popular festival.





Senior Art Enrichment Programs

Thanks to grants and donations, Arts on Main provides professional art instruction for seniors living in local retirement communities. To date, we are delighted to offer classes at three local senior communities.

Youth Art Enrichment Programs

Donors like you make it possible for Arts on Main to offer Youth Art Enrichment Programs that provide art education for our youngest neighbors. Our signature before-school Palette Pals program, for example, allows local teachers in all five Gloucester County elementary schools to offer before-school art education with a STEM focus (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math). In the summer, we offer youth summer art camps. Your donations made these camps free for the first time in June 2023!

All of your support this past year has laid the groundwork for the next phase of Arts on Main's growth. In the coming year, we plan to embark on a construction project that will include necessary roof repairs, a ceramics studio, and the addition of a partial second floor with over 2,000 square feet of additional multi-purpose space.

With these new resources, we will be able to meet a growing demand for pottery classes, more free youth art camps, multi-day workshops, and new classes for non-visual arts like music, creative writing, and performance arts. We are eagerly looking forward to building on the foundation that you and other like-minded donors have built for us. Thank you for your support and continued interest!


